We are **Safe Space to Speak / Safle Saff i Siarad**, **S**³. We are the governing board and primary decision—makers for Dyfodol Ni. We are a diverse group of young people from across Ceredigion, and we are the representative body for young people throughout the county. We will lobby for the views and ambitions of young people in Ceredigion.

OUR MAIN CAMPAIGN AIM IS TO ESTABLISH A NETWORK OF SAFE SPACES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE, AND AMPLIFY YOUTH VOICE.

We aim to act as a kind of union for young people, representing youth voice on committees and with steering groups. The aim is that any and every project or development that claims to be for the benefit of young people will have to consult with S³ first. We will demand that people in power listen to young people's views.



THE ROLE: BOARD MEMBER



We will meet monthly to review Dyfodol Ni's progress, discuss our campaign aims, how we will move forward, and direct the movements of the project. We will lobby for change, and represent the voice of young people in Ceredigion.

Responsibilities will include:

- Attending all meetings (in-person or virtually)
- Ensuring that all meetings are conducted in a manner consistent with our values as a group
- Attending additional meetings of strategic boards, new or developing projects
- Engaging in outreach to organisations, stakeholders, strategic boards, new projects etc. to further the campaign aims
- Making decisions on the progress of Dyfodol Ni
- Overseeing the progress of Feelz on Wheelz, monitor and evaluate the service
- Recruiting new members, and sitting on recruitment panels for Feelz on Wheelz
- Evaluating ongoing consultation with young people, and adjust services and campaign aims as required
- Developing and maintaining a social media and marketing presence
- Engaging with the press and other promotional outlets where necessary
- Conducting research on campaign aims and to keep informed on new and developing projects and issues
